Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2024/2025

The following are the dates applicable for admission to First Year

The school will commence accepting applications for admission in	1st September 2023
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission at	10th November 2023
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	1st December 2023
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	15th December 2023

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2024/2025

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's Special Class which caters for children with a diagnosis of Autism / Autistic Spectrum Disorder

The school will commence accepting applications for admission to the special class in	11th September 2023
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class at	10th November 2023
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	1st December 2023
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	12th April 2023

***Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**
